Your Submission

Kilfenora is a beautiful and historic town that I've become even more grateful for these past 2 years with such restrictions in that our local community became a lifeline. However, it also highlighted the lack of facilities available to the community that lives here. Lack of Community Spaces: There is no community public park or playground for Kilfenora residences old or young. The local community sporting complex also know as the 'Deanery' is an ideal location for such an amenity as it is already heavily used by locals participating in GAA and has ample safe parking, making it accessible for the whole community. Action: a children's playground, flood lighting and a walking track around the field would positively benefit all generations living in this area. Also would like to see the Deanery as a registered community

space on the Kilfenora County Development Plan map. Lack of financial institutions
The Post Office could provide this service along with other services.

Lack of Green Infrastructure: This sporting complex (The Deanery) is within walking distance of the village. However, the 80km, unpedestrianized route to this amenity poses a serious safety risk to the local school children, village residence and tourists whom use this route for recreational and educational purposes. Action: installing a cycle / walking lane and reducing the speed limit to this community space would improve the wellbeing of the whole community. A cycle/walk way to the Kilfenora Mart would also be of benefit and the road here is wide enough to allow this action to be implemented quite quickly and cost effectively. I also would like to see the Mart recognized on the Kilfenora CDP as it is an important part of the heritage and culture of Kilfenora. Maybe extending the boundary from the Deanery to the Mart is an option? It may be appropriate to highlight Lemenah's Castle's ties to Kilfenora perhaps in the mapping system as it too is a huge part of the heritage here.


