A Chara,

We wish to make a submission to the Clare County Council Development Plan 2023-2029.

- (1) The proposed town centre outlined in the map extends partially onto our property at Folio [REDACTED]. This area of land has been used for parking purposes since 1958. Our father, Tom Malone founded Clonbony Football and Hurling Club in 1936 and from 1958 this club trained in the adjoining area of land, Folio [REDACTED] identified in Land Registry as GAA Pitch. Trainers, coaches, footballers and attendees have always parked vehicles in this area. Other events have been held in this area such as Duffy's, Fossett's and Courtney's Circus', various funfairs and the Town and Country Fair annually. During the Willie Clancy Summer School when the town is at capacity, attendees also use the area for parking. This area has been used for parking purposes since the late fifties and we request that it should remain so therefore we ask that the town centre boundary is moved out to exclude the partial Folio [REDACTED]
- (2) The County Plan has identified our property at [REDACTED] as Strategic Residential Reserve (SR3). This area of land has always been used for the Community, for football and hurling training since 1958 as well as facilitating Duffy's, Fossett's and Courtney's Circus', various funfairs and the Town and County Fair annually. This is identified on Land Registry as a GAA Pitch. We request that this land be removed from Strategic Residential Reserve.
