Mrs Mary Browne (landowner), would like to make the following submission for your approval.

We wish to include the area below and beside SR2 and REC 1 over to the boundary with the LNDR, and the REC1 (pitch and putt course), and to zone these areas for residential use. All the areas are beside the settlement boundary, and the REC1 is within this. The development of these areas will assist in consolidating the core of the village. The pitch and putt (REC1) is no longer retained in recreational use, and has been returned to farmland. All areas are already bounding residential- zoned land and benefit from road, path, sewerage, electrical and water infrastructure, with most situated within the settlement boundary.

In the lower part of the village on the school road, before the settlement boundary and between it and the Limerick Blowmoulding Factory, across (north) of the C1 area, which is currently agriculture, we wish to zone for residential purposes.
