Topic - Submission by Michael Glynn on the Draft Clare County Development Plan 2023-2029. This submission specifically relates to the 'inclusion of land within the development boundary of Behagh Cluster' as outlined on map p264 of the VOLUME 3(d) West Clare Municipal District Area Settlement Plans dated 10th December 2021.

> Please include the lands with an area of 0.5ha as outlined on the attached map within the development boundary of Behagh Cluster. The lands are owned by Michael Glynn. The land is above the level of the local road and fairly level throughout. Currently in use as grasslands and centrally located within the existing cluster of five established dwellings. The site is located to the east of the local road, the L-50222. Reasons for inclusion;

- The principle of planning has been established on this site for two dwellings under Reg. No. 18/321 to the west of the site and under Reg. No. 15/818 (and previously under Reg. No. 10/733) to the east of the site.
- There is a dwelling constructed on the adjoining site to the east(neighbours land) and there are two dwellings constructed on the adjoining site to the west (other neighbours land). The map in the previous County Development Plan and the Draft CDP has not yet taken account of the development permitted elsewhere in Behagh as outlined as follows. The site to the east of the subject site has a dwelling permitted under Ref. No. 13/375 and this dwelling has been constructed and completed - different landholding - Jordan Family. Two sites west of the subject site have been permitted and constructed to date under Ref. No. 00/688 and Ref. No. 04/691 - different landholding - Conrov Family.
- Any exercise of discretion can properly take account of the fact that the designated cluster boundary no longer reflects the reality 'on the ground'.
- The 0.5 ha site is centrally located within the Behagh Cluster and is an infill site suitable for development and would consolidate the existing cluster. The siting and design of the proposed single storey dwellings will sit comfortable on the sites and within the cluster of Behagh.
- The sites comply with the EPA Guidelines for sewerage disposal via individual sewerage treatment systems as permitted by Clare Co. Co. Water supply is via the public mains along the roadside boundary.
